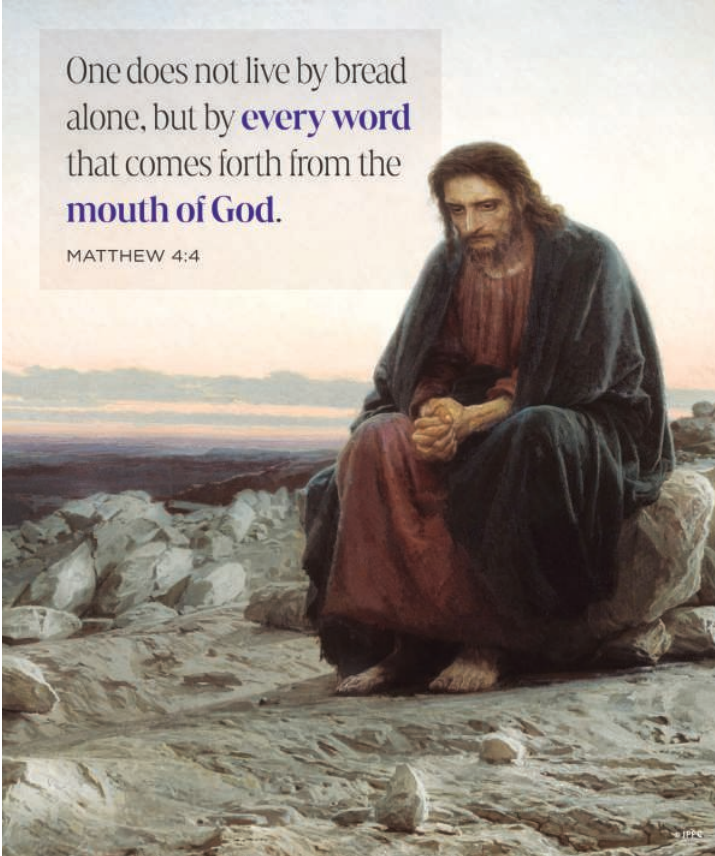


The First Sunday of Lent

February 22, 2026

One does not live by bread alone, but by **every word** that comes forth from the **mouth of God.**

MATTHEW 4:4



## Reading I: Genesis 2: 7-9,3:1-7

God creates man from the dust of the earth. He then places him in a beautiful garden. In that garden, midst every other feature, there are two significant trees: One the tree of life, the other the tree of knowledge of good and evil. Eventually man succumbs to the devil's lure about the latter tree.

## Reading II: Romans 5: 12-19, or 5:12, 17-19

St. Paul tells us that sin invaded the world through Adam. And death came as a consequence. But the obedience of one man, "the New Adam," Jesus Christ, will save many for their belief in Him.

## The Gospel: Matthew 4: 1-11

We go back a chapter from the previous two weeks to read the dramatic story of Jesus' temptations. They involve three of our own common temptations and so we are encouraged by Jesus' triumph over them and the fact that He never sinned. This last would be impossible for an all-good God. But we marvel at His strength.

## Faith Formation

Ash Wednesday just came upon us this past Wednesday and it is time to make a firm decision as to what type of 'sacrifice' you wish to 'do' or offer during Lent. As you know, this is a season of prayer, fasting and abstinence in preparation for the greatest mystery of our faith, the Paschal Mystery- the Crucifixion and Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. There is no 'Resurrection without the Crucifixion' as they say. Suffering has a meaning and Pope St. JP II has offered us great reflections in his encyclical 'Salvifici Doloris' which is available for free online at Vatican.org. If you have never read an encyclical, this may be one you wish to start! Everyone has some sort of suffering and many wonder the whys? Our loving God became man to show us how to live and how to love and how to suffer and why... for repentance for sin although He was without sin. There are 'salvific' benefits either for ourselves or others if we join our suffering with Christ for the remission of sins...ours and others. So, try to do one thing every day as a 'sacrifice' for the remission of sin... a Morning Offering prayer may be considered, a fasting or skipping a meal or favorite food, a visit to the Adoration Chapel or even signing up for an hour a week, a decade of the Rosary or even an entire rosary perhaps with the family, reading a Scripture verse, attendance at daily mass, prayers before meals, acts of kindness to spouse/children/family/co-workers. There are many. Pick one... or more and as Nike says "just do it"! Join us for planning our programs and send us your ideas. Next weekend we kick off our Capital Campaign... why not volunteer to help... time/talent or treasure... choice is yours... you will be glad you did... so will God. St. Thomas Aquinas, pray for us.

Again, the basics of the Baltimore catechism can be recalled: Who made you? God made you. Why did God make you? To know Him, to love Him and to serve Him in this world so that I may be happy with Him for all of eternity in the next! This is the meaning of life; this is the goal of life= Heaven. But the bigger question is 'why me?' Since each person is unique with their specific genetics and identity and there is no one else like me, then why me? Well, that is for each person to grow in relationship with God his loving Creator and find out...not all at once, but gradually through trial and error and suffering and grace. God is love. God is the Creator of all life. We are the beloved. An author once asked a person, 'are you seeking God, or is God seeking you' and the person answered 'I am seeking God' and the author responded 'stop, turn around, He is right behind you and has been seeking you since the Garden' (Sacred Romance; John Eldridge). Further Eldridge opines 'for above all else, the Christian life is a love affair of the heart...our lives are not a random series of events; they tell a Story that has meaning...we would like to picture goodness as being synonymous with safety'. Let us write our story day by day in communication with the Master 'Story teller' and be in love with Him as He is in love with us!

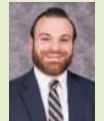
